Jezebel wines are produced by **Daedalus Cellars** with the intent of providing wine that is well-balanced and interesting and designed for immediate consumption.

The 2008 Pinot Noir is a blend of wine from several Oregon vineyards including:

Battle Creek vineyard, Willamette Valley (33%)

Bolton Vineyard, Columbia Valley (9%)

Carabella Vineyard, Chehalem Mtn (8%)

Melrose Vineyard, Umpqua (5%)

Other Willamette Valley Vineyards (45%)

The vineyards were managed to yield between two and three tons-per-acre. The grapes from each vineyard source were separated into small fermentors. The resulting wine was aged in 60% stainless steel, 35% neutral and 5% new barrels. The various sources were blended to produce a wine that is fruit-forward, well-balanced and surprisingly complex.

2008 was a fantastic vintage in Oregon which produced beautifully balanced wines with a wonderful depth of flavor. This wine has bright red fruit characters with soft tannins and should pair well with salmon, chicken and mushrooms. It is enjoyable now, but it may also cellar well for one to three years.
