## 2008 SCHEDULE OF NEW RELEASES

### *March 2008*

#### 2005 Daedalus Nyarady Pinot Noir

This is the Labyrinth squared – dense and powerful with focused fruit and exquisite grace. This first release is a blend of the very best barrels from our Carabella, Maresh and Seven Springs production. We're calling it our "über-Pinot". We still have to come up with a name, and a label. (220 six-packs produced)

### *August 2008*

#### 2007 Jezebel Blanc

The blend will again be a fully produced (rather than part negociant) wine. It will be a blend of around 45% Pinot Blanc, and 10-20% each of Pinot Gris, Riesling and Gewürztraminer. (Estimate 1300 cases)

#### 2007 Jezebel Pinot Noir

We have again produced around 3000 cases of wine specifically for the Jezebel Pinot Noir. Having control in the vineyard and winery has allowed us to create a wine that is just what it should be: fruit-forward and well-balanced with soft, round tannins. We will also add whatever wine we declassify from Daedalus and will purchase a little additional bulk wine to bring us to our production goal of 4000 cases.

### *September 2008*

#### 2007 Daedalus Cellars Pinot Gris

We'll be staying with the same dry, full-bodied, Alsatian-style Pinot Gris. This year the wine will be a blend of Carabella, Croft, Mahonia and Murto vineyards. (Estimate 750 cases)

#### 2007 Daedalus Cellars Riesling

Dry Riesling from sustainably farmed, older vines on south Maresh vineyard. (Estimate 200 cases)

#### 2007 Daedalus Cellars Grüner Veltliner

Another vintage from the 0.6 acres at Elton Vineyards. (Estimate 120 cases)

#### 2005 Daedalus Cellars Chardonnay

Wente-clone Chardonnay from Lia's Vineyard (formerly Jacob Hart Vineyard) in the Chehalem Mountain AVA. (Estimate 80 cases – bottling February 2008)

#### 2006 Daedalus Cellars Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

A blend of several vineyards again, including Carabella, Seven Springs, and Maresh vineyards. We had a significant increase in production in 2006 which will allow us to increase allocations finally. (Estimate 1200 cases – bottling in January 2008)

### *September 2008 (continued)*

#### 2006 Daedalus Syrah

Single-vineyard Syrah from McDuffee vineyard outside The Dalles, eastern Oregon. This is a Rhone-style syrah with elegant tannin and acidity balancing the dark berries and mineral flavors (estimate 200 cases – bottling January 2008). This will be our last vintage of McDuffee Syrah as we are focusing out red wine production exclusively on Pinot Noir.

### *November 2008*

#### 2006 Daedalus Cellars Labyrinth Pinot Noir

It's a blend of the best barrels in the cellar, comprising fruit from Maresh, Carabella and Seven Springs vineyards, with the same depth and complexity, and luscious mouthfeel for which we strive. (Estimate 600 six-packs – bottling January 2008)

#### 2006 Daedalus Cellars Maresh Vineyard Pinot Noir

This is a blend of three barrels of Pinot Noir from Maresh Vineyard that were particularly exceptional. The wine is classic Dundee Hills: bright red fruit flavors mingling with pronounced minerality, freshly turned earth, and great acidity. It has the concentration and complexity you would expect from an older, well-tended vineyard. The fruit is from our organically-farmed southern half of the vineyard. (Estimate 140 six-packs)"
