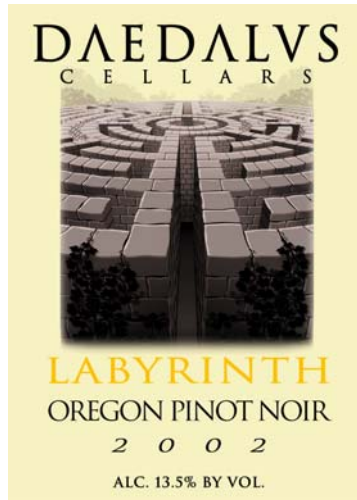

Daedalus (day-duh-lus) Cellars is a small, family-owned winery in Oregon's Willamette Valley. We source from some of the best vineyards in the state and handle the fruit minimally and carefully to create balanced wines with complex fruit and elegant structure. Their refinement makes them natural partners for a wide range of foods and ensures their graceful maturation.

2002 was another great vintage in Oregon. The wines are concentrated, fleshy and naturally well-balanced, and the Labyrinth represents the best Pinot Noir that we can offer from the vintage. Old-vine Pommard from Red Hills Estate Vineyard and Wadenswil from Hawks View Vineyard provide elegance and structure, and young-vine Dijon-clone fruit from Ribbon Ridge Vineyard adds to the plump fleshiness. Spontaneous fermentation and extremely careful handling preserve a sexy mouthfeel and a rich mid-palate and a finish that goes on and on. We recommend that you decant this wine.
