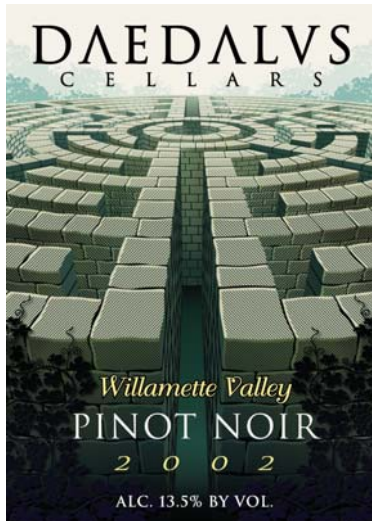

Daedalus (day-duh-lus) Cellars is a small, family-owned winery in Oregon's Willamette Valley. We source from some of the best vineyards in the state and handle the fruit minimally and carefully to create balanced wines with complex fruit and elegant structure. Their refinement makes them natural partners for a wide range of foods and ensures their graceful maturation.

This majority of our 2002 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir comes from a small, meticulously managed vineyard outside of Sherwood. Wadenswil clone Pinot Noir was cropped to around 1.7 tons per acre to give us rich, concentrated flavors. Old-vine Pommard from Red Hills Estate Vineyard, and young Dijon-clone fruit from Ribbon Ridge Vineyard complete the blend. Spontaneous fermentation and extremely careful handling build complexity and preserve the natural expression of the vineyards. We recommend that you decant this wine.
