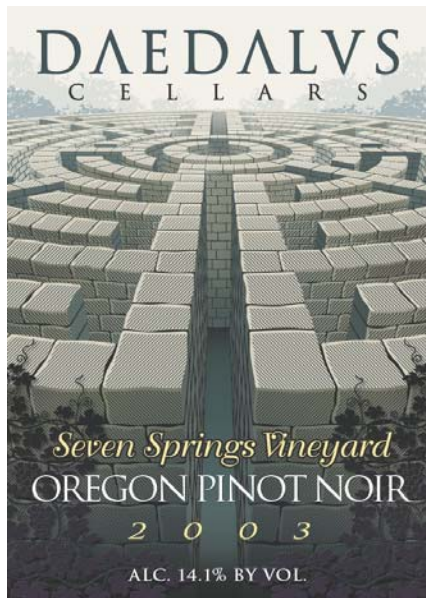

Daedalus (DAY-duh-lus) Cellars is a small, family-owned winery in Oregon's Willamette Valley. We source from some of the best vineyards in the state and handle the fruit minimally and carefully to create balanced wines with complex fruit and elegant structure. Their refinement makes them natural partners for a wide range of foods and ensures their graceful maturation.

This two-barrel blend from Seven Springs Vineyard was fermented with 25% whole clusters and aged in 50% new French oak for 17 months. Made entirely from Pommard clone, the wine is concentrated, with dense aromas and flavors of violets, oolong, black raspberries, cherries and stonefruit.

We recommend that you decant this wine, or cellar it for several years.
