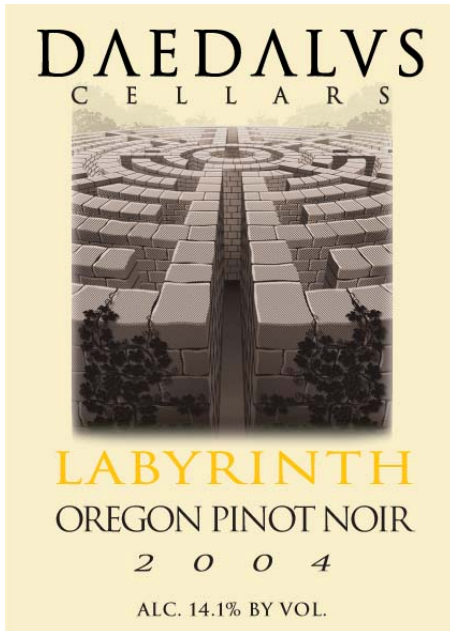

Daedalus (DAY-duh-lus) Cellars is a small, family-owned winery in Oregon's Willamette Valley. We source from some of the best vineyards in the state and handle the fruit minimally and carefully to create balanced wines with complex fruit and elegant structure. Their refinement makes them natural partners for a wide range of foods and ensures their graceful maturation.

The 2004 Labyrinth is again mostly Pommard clone Pinot Noir. Old-vine fruit from Seven Springs and Murto vineyards are blended with fruit from Carabella and Momtazi vineyards to create the blend that is the pinnacle of our Pinot Noir production. The wine maintains the focused fruit flavors, powerful structure and fleshy mouthfeel that have come to characterize this wine.

It should drink well on release with decanting, but will develop greater nuance and richness over the next seven to ten years.
