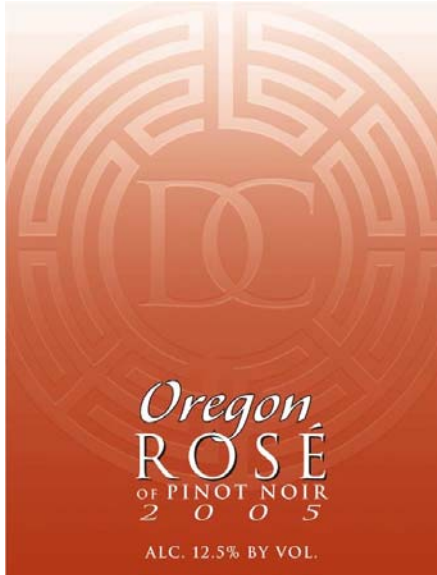

Daedalus (day-duh-lus) Cellars is a small family-owned winery. We source from some of the best vineyards in the state and handle the fruit minimally and carefully to create balanced wines with complex fruit and elegant structure. Their refinement makes them natural partners for a wide range of foods and ensures their graceful maturation.

Our 2005 Rosé comes equally from Pommard clone Pinot Noir from Seven Springs Vineyard in the Eola Hills, and Mariafeld clone Pinot Noir from Battlecreek Vineyard outside of Salem. It was inoculated with two different yeasts and fermented in small (55 gallon) stainless steel vessels. The 2005 harvest produced some wonderful Rosé wines and we think that this is our best yet. Its crisp fruitiness makes it perfect for a wide range of summer dishes and ideal for barbequed foods. It is also very refreshing as aperitif. We recommend that you serve this wine slightly chilled.
